Why should you vote?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2016, 43% of the eligible voting-age population (nearly 100 million Americans) did *not* cast a vote for president; and 38.6% did *not* vote for any office.

In 2016, the Black voter turnout rate declined for the first time in 20 years in a presidential election, falling from a record-high 66.6% in 2012 to 59.6% in 2016.

Arkansas's absentee and mail-in voting procedures

Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

· Excuse required to request an absentee ballot

2020 state absentee / mail-in voting status:

 Coronavirus updates: Voters in the November 3, 2020, general election can cite concerns over COVID-19 as a valid excuse for voting absentee.

Election Day: November 3



Deadlines to know for voting in Arkansas

Voter registration deadline:

October 4, 2020

Thirty days before an election.

Early in-person voting deadlines:

Early in-person voting begins 15 days before the Election.

In-person absentee voting ends the Monday before the Election.

Absentee / Mail-In voting ballot deadlines:

Request must be received by

October 27, 2020

Seven days before the election

Ballot submission deadline:

By mail: October 27, 2020. In person: By close of business November 2, 2020.

Voter ID Requirements

Valid Forms of ID include:

Shows the name of voter; Shows photo of voter; Is issued by:

- US (e.g., Passport, Military
 Accredited postsecondary
- ID, public assistance card)
 State of AR (e.g., driver's license or photo ID card, concealed handgun carry license, voter verification

card)

Accredited postsecondary educational institution in AR (i.e., employee badge or ID) The administrator of long-term care or residential care facility licensed by AR, attesting that the voter is a resident; **AND**

If shows expiration date, is not expired or expired no more than 4 years before date of election $% \left({{{\left({{{{\bf{n}}}} \right)}_{i}}_{i}}_{i}} \right)$

If no ID: Cast a provisional ballot and complete a sworn statement that you're the person who is registered to vote.
