

# Get out the vote in California

#### Why should you vote?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2016, 43% of the eligible voting-age population (nearly 100 million Americans) did *not* cast a vote for president; and 38.6% did *not* vote for any office.

In 2016, the Black voter turnout rate declined for the first time in 20 years in a presidential election, falling from a record-high 66.6% in 2012 to 59.6% in 2016.

# Deadlines to know for voting in California

#### Voter registration deadline:

#### October 19, 2020

Fifteen days before an election. Same-day registration is permitted 14 days before an election and on Election Day

### Absentee / Mail-In voting ballot deadlines:

Request must be received by

#### October 27, 2020

Seven days before the election

#### Early in-person voting deadlines:

Early in-person voting **begins 29 days before the election**. Varies by county. Voters should contact their county elections office to see if they offer early voting. Early in-person voting **ends the day before the election**. Varies by county.

#### **Ballot submission deadline:**

By mail: Postmarked by November 3, 2020 (Election Day) and received within 17 days. In person: By 8:00 pm on November 3, 2020 (Election Day).

#### **Voter ID Requirements**

#### **NO ID REQUIRED FOR MOST VOTERS**. FOR FIRST-TIME VOTERS IN A FEDERAL ELECTION:

Voter registration requires, in this order:

- Current driver's
  license number or
- Last 4 digits of social security number or
- State-assigned unique number
- \* shows voter's name and address
