

# Get out the vote in Nevada

#### Why should you vote?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2016, 43% of the eligible voting-age population (nearly 100 million Americans) did *not* cast a vote for president; and 38.6% did *not* vote for any office.

In 2016, the Black voter turnout rate declined for the first time in 20 years in a presidential election, falling from a recordhigh 66.6% in 2012 to 59.6% in 2016.

# Nevada's absentee and mail-in voting procedures

### Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

 No excuse required to request an absentee ballot

### 2020 state absentee / mail-in voting status:

 Coronavirus updates: Mail-in ballots sent automatically to all voters in the November 3, 2020, general election.

## Deadlines to know for voting in Nevada

#### Voter registration deadline:

#### October 6, 2020

Twenty-eight days before an election in-person; postmarked 28 days before if registering by mail; 5 days before if registering online.

Deadlines for special elections are different;

Same-day registration is permitted during early voting and on Election Day

#### Early in-person voting deadlines:

Early in-person voting begins 17 days before the election.

In-person absentee voting ends at 4 days before the Election.

#### Absentee / Mail-In voting ballot deadlines:

Request must be received by

#### October 27, 2020

Seven days before the election

#### **Ballot submission deadline:**

In person: Received by 7:00 pm on November 3rd, 2020 (Election Day).

By mail: Postmarked by November 3rd, 2020 and received within 7 days.

#### **Voter ID Requirements**

#### NO ID REQUIRED FOR MOST VOTERS.

FOR FIRST-TIME VOTERS IN A FEDERAL ELECTION:

Voter registration requires, in this order:

- Current driver's license number or
- Last 4 digits of social security number or
- State-assigned unique number

If haven't provided above information

- Photo ID or
- Copy of utility bill, bank statement, paycheck or government document including check\*
