

# Get out the vote in New Mexico

#### Why should you vote?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2016, 43% of the eligible voting-age population (nearly 100 million Americans) did *not* cast a vote for president; and 38.6% did *not* vote for any office.

In 2016, the Black voter turnout rate declined for the first time in 20 years in a presidential election, falling from a recordhigh 66.6% in 2012 to 59.6% in 2016.

# New Mexico's absentee and mail-in voting procedures

Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

 No excuse required to request an absentee hallot

### 2020 state absentee / mail-in voting status:

 Coronavirus updates: Counties authorized to send mail-in ballot applications automatically to all voters in the November 3, 2020 election.

## Deadlines to know for voting in New Mexico

#### Voter registration deadline:

#### October 6, 2020

Twenty-eight days before an election.

Same-day registration is permitted 28 days prior to the election until the Saturday prior, and will be offered on Election Day beginning in 2021

#### **Early in-person voting deadlines:**

Early in-person voting begins 28 days before the election.

In-person absentee voting ends 2 days before the Election.

### Absentee / Mail-In voting ballot deadlines:

Request must be received by

#### October 29, 2020

Thursday before the election

#### Ballot submission deadline:

November 3rd, 2020 (Election Day) by 7:00 pm.

#### **Voter ID Requirements**

#### NO ID REQUIRED FOR MOST VOTERS.

FOR FIRST-TIME VOTERS IN A FEDERAL ELECTION:

Voter registration requires, in this order:

- Current driver's license number or
- Last 4 digits of social security number or
- State-assigned unique number
- If haven't provided above information
- Photo ID or
- Copy of utility bill, bank statement, paycheck or government document including check\*
