

# Get out the vote in **Oklahoma**

## Why should you vote?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2016, 43% of the eligible voting-age population (nearly 100 million Americans) did not cast a vote for president; and 38.6% did *not* vote for any office.

In 2016, the Black voter turnout rate declined for the first time in 20 years in a presidential election, falling from a recordhigh 66.6% in 2012 to 59.6% in 2016.

No excuse required to request an absentee

Coronavirus updates: Voters in the November 3, 2020, general election can cite concerns over COVID-19 as a valid excuse for voting absentee.

#### **Election Day: November 3**



### **Deadlines to know for** voting in Oklahoma

#### Voter registration deadline:

#### October 9, 2020

Twenty-five days before an election.

#### Early in-person voting deadlines:

Early in-person voting begins 5 days before the election.

In-person absentee voting ends at 2pm the day before the Election.

#### **Absentee / Mail-In voting ballot** deadlines:

Request must be received by

#### October 27, 2020

Tuesday before the election

#### **Ballot submission deadline:**

Received by 7:00 pm on November 3, 2020 (Election Day).

#### **Voter ID Requirements**

Voter identification card issued by appropriate county elections board#

IDs issued by US Government, OK, or Fedrecognized Tribal government# with:

- Voter's name and photograph AND
- Current as of date of voting unless the ID is valid indefinitely

# Voter's name substantially conforms to name in precinct registry

Voter who doesn't produce acceptable ID may sign statement under oath to affirm identify and then cast provisional ballot
