### Why should you vote?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2016, 43% of the eligible voting-age population (nearly 100 million Americans) did *not* cast a vote for president; and 38.6% did *not* vote for any office.

In 2016, the Black voter turnout rate declined for the first time in 20 years in a presidential election, falling from a recordhigh 66.6% in 2012 to 59.6% in 2016.

# Colorado's absentee and mail-in voting procedures

## Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

Every voter receives a mail-in ballot by default

### 2020 state absentee / mail-in voting status:

 No announced changes to voting procedures due to the coronavirus pandemic.

## Deadlines to know for voting in Colorado

#### Voter registration deadline:

#### October 26, 2020

Eight days before an election.

Same-day registration is permitted during early voting and on Election Day;

Deadlines for voter registration drives are 22 days before an election

## Absentee / Mail-In voting ballot deadlines:

Request must be received by

#### **Application Not Required**

Automatically sends ballots to all eligible voters

#### **Ballot submission deadline:**

Mail ballots must be received by 7:00 pm on November 3, 2020 (Election Day).

#### **Voter ID Requirements**

#### If ID shows address, must be CO address:

- CO driver's license or ID card #
- U.S. Passport #
- Medicare or Medicaid card #
- Certified U.S. birth certificate or naturalization document
- Group residential care facility verification
- Tribal certificate
  - # current \* with photo
- Name & address on copy of utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, or government document including check (within 60 days)
- Employee ID issued by US, CO or their subdivisions #\*
- U.S. military or veterans ID #\*
- Student ID issued by CO post- secondary school #\*
