### Why should you vote?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2016, 43% of the eligible voting-age population (nearly 100 million Americans) did *not* cast a vote for president; and 38.6% did *not* vote for any office.

In 2016, the Black voter turnout rate declined for the first time in 20 years in a presidential election, falling from a recordhigh 66.6% in 2012 to 59.6% in 2016.

# Florida's absentee and mail-in voting procedures

## Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

 No excuse required to request an absentee ballot

## 2020 state absentee / mail-in voting status:

 No announced changes to voting procedures due to the coronavirus pandemic.

## **Deadlines to know for voting in Florida**

#### **Voter registration deadline:**

#### October 5, 2020

Twenty-nine days before an election.

### Absentee / Mail-In voting ballot deadlines:

Request must be received by

#### October 24, 2020

10 days before the election

#### **Ballot submission deadline:**

Must be received by 7:00 pm on November 3, 2020 (Election Day).

#### **Voter ID Requirements**

#### Current ID with photo & signature:

- FL driver's license or FL state ID
- U.S. Passport
- Debit or credit card
- Military ID
- Student ID\*
- Retirement center ID
- Neighborhood association ID
- Public assistance ID
- · Veterans health ID card
- License to carry concealed weapon or firearm
- Employee ID card issued by entity of Federal Government, or of FL, county, or municipality

\*County determines validity if no expiration date
If above photo ID has no signature: need
additional ID with signature

Provisional ballot counts if signature matches voter registration record
