Why should you vote?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2016, 43% of the eligible voting-age population (nearly 100 million Americans) did *not* cast a vote for president; and 38.6% did *not* vote for any office.

In 2016, the Black voter turnout rate declined for the first time in 20 years in a presidential election, falling from a recordhigh 66.6% in 2012 to 59.6% in 2016.

Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

· Excuse required to request an absentee ballot

2020 state absentee / mail-in voting status:

 No announced changes to voting procedures due to the coronavirus pandemic.

Election Day: November 3



Deadlines to know for voting in Louisiana

Voter registration deadline:

October 4, 2020

Thirty days before an election; 20 days before if registering online.

Absentee / Mail-In voting ballot deadlines:

Request must be received by

October 30, 2020

Four days before the election

Ballot submission deadline:

Must be received by your registrar by 4:30 pm CST November 2, 2020.

Voter ID Requirements

- LA driver's license
- DMV-issued special ID card
- Other generally recognized picture ID card with voter's name and signature
- Digital license via LA Wallet*
- * Smartphone app by LA Office of Motor Vehicles

If none of above, you can complete and sign affidavit including date of birth and mother's maiden name
