

Get out the vote in Nebraska

Why should you vote?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2016, 43% of the eligible voting-age population (nearly 100 million Americans) did not cast a vote for president; and 38.6% did not vote for any office.

In 2016, the Black voter turnout rate declined for the first time in 20 years in a presidential election, falling from a recordhigh 66.6% in 2012 to 59.6% in 2016.

Nebraska's absentee and mail-in voting procedures

Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

No excuse required to request an absentee

2020 state absentee / mail-in voting status:

Coronavirus updates: Mail-in ballot applications sent automatically to all voters in the November 3, 2020, general election.

Election Day: November 3



Deadlines to know for voting in Nebraska

Voter registration deadline:

October 23, 2020

Eleven days before an election; 18 days before if registering online.

Absentee / Mail-In voting ballot deadlines:

Request must be received by

October 16, 2020

Third Friday before the election

Ballot submission deadline:

Must be received by 8:00 pm on November 3, 2020 (Election Day).

Voter ID Requirements

NO ID REQUIRED FOR MOST VOTERS.

FOR FIRST-TIME VOTERS IN A FEDERAL ELECTION:

Voter registration requires, If haven't provided above in this order: information

- Current driver's license · Photo ID or number or
- Last 4 digits of social security number or
- State-assigned unique number
- * shows voter's name and address
- Copy of utility bill, bank statement, paycheck or government document including check*
