New Jersey

Why should you vote?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2016, 43% of the eligible voting-age population (nearly 100 million Americans) did *not* cast a vote for president; and 38.6% did *not* vote for any office.

In 2016, the Black voter turnout rate declined for the first time in 20 years in a presidential election, falling from a recordhigh 66.6% in 2012 to 59.6% in 2016.

New Jersey's absentee and mail-in voting procedures

Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

 No excuse required to request an absentee ballot

2020 state absentee / mail-in voting status:

 Coronavirus updates: Sending all registered voters an absentee ballot for the November 3, 2020 election.

Election Day: November 3



Deadlines to know for voting in New Jersey

Voter registration deadline:

October 13, 2020

Twenty-one days before an election.

Absentee / Mail-In voting ballot deadlines:

Request must be received by

October 27, 2020

Seven days before the election

Ballot submission deadline:

In person: Must be received by close of polls on November 3rd, 2020 (Election Day). By mail: Postmarked by Election Day and received by County Board of Elections within 48 hours of the polls closing.

Voter ID Requirements

NO ID REQUIRED FOR MOST VOTERS.

FOR FIRST-TIME VOTERS IN A FEDERAL ELECTION:

Voter registration requires,

- in this order:
- number or
 Last 4 digits of social
- security number or State-assigned unique
- State-assigned unique number
- Current driver's license If haven't provided above number or information
 - · Photo ID or
 - Copy of utility bill, bank statement, paycheck or government document including check*
