

# Get out the vote in West Virginia

#### Why should you vote?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2016, 43% of the eligible voting-age population (nearly 100 million Americans) did *not* cast a vote for president; and 38.6% did *not* vote for any office.

In 2016, the Black voter turnout rate declined for the first time in 20 years in a presidential election, falling from a record-high 66.6% in 2012 to 59.6% in 2016.

# West Virginia's absentee and mail-in voting procedures

### Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

· Excuse required to request an absentee ballot

# 2020 state absentee / mail-in voting status:

• Coronavirus updates: Absentee/mail-in ballot eligibility in the November 3, 2020, general election extended to all voters.

#### Election Day: November 3



# Deadlines to know for voting in West Virginia

#### Voter registration deadline:

#### October 13, 2020

Twenty-one days before an election Absentee / Mail-In voting ballot deadlines:

Request must be received by

#### October 28, 2020

Six days before the election

#### **Ballot submission deadline:**

By mail: Postmarked by November 3, 2020 (Election Day) and received by November 9, 2020. In person: November 2, 2020.

Show one ID at the polls. Must be valid and unexpired:

- Utility bill or bank statement
- (w/in 6 mos. of election date) Health insurance card issued to voter
